The Advanced Learning Plan (ALP) is an individualized plan for identified gifted students grades K – 12. The ALP is a record of programming options and academic or talent goals that support the student’s strength area(s) and affective or behavioral needs. Through collaboration of the student, parents, and school personnel, the ALP guides educational planning, course selection, and instructional decisions toward post-secondary and career success.
