

STUDENT USE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES

(Responsible Use Agreement)

Superintendent Effective Date: May 4, 2010

In order to provide for the appropriate use of District Information Technology Resources (DITR), and in keeping with Board of Education policy and District regulation, the following Responsible Use Agreement (RUA) form has been developed. Before being granted privileges to use the District's technology, including Internet access, e-mail, computers and networks, all students, unless they are 18 years of age or older, must have this form signed by a parent or guardian. This form is only valid until the student moves to another school or has a change in guardianship. Students and parents should read the District's policy (JS) and regulation (JS-R) on Student Use of Information Technology Resources, which can be found online at the District's website using the following links:

Alternatively, students or parents may request a printed copy from school administration.

Students in grades K-5:

- Complete the Student Acknowledgement section of this form. Students are not required to sign the form.
Have a parent/guardian explain the District's and parent's expectations about the following:
responsible use of the District's Information Technology Resources
the District's ability to monitor use of its information technology resources
there is no expectation of privacy when using these resources
there are consequences for inappropriate use, which may include, depending on the nature of the misuse, loss of privileges to use District technology resources, in-school or out-of-school disciplinary action, and/or referral to law enforcement agencies.
A Parent/Guardian is required to complete and sign the Parent/Guardian Acknowledgement section of this form.
Return the completed form to the school.

Students in grades 6-12:

- Complete and sign the Student Acknowledgement section of this document.
A Parent/Guardian is required to complete and sign the Parent/Guardian Acknowledgement section of this form, unless the student is 18 or older.
Return the completed form to the school.
