Dress Code Guidelines

Research indicates that appropriate school dress has a positive impact on performance and behavior.

To support achievement and maintain a positive learning environment for all staff and students, we ask that the following types of clothing **not be worn** during the school day.

- Clothing that...
- Is provocative or immodest
 - Contains profanity or obscene/lewd text or graphics
 - Promotes alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or weapons
 - Advocates sex or sexual activity

Gentlemen Cats, NO...

- Muscle shirts
- Pants that sag excessively

Lady Wildcats, NO...

- Off-the-shoulder tops, strapless tops, spaghetti straps
- Clothing that exposes undergarments
- Clothing that is transparent
- Low cut tops that expose cleavage
- Short mini-skirts or short shorts

All Wildcats.... No clothing that exposes the torso, including side, back, or middle.
