

Homecoming FAQ



For Parents & Students

What is Homecoming? Homecoming is a time to celebrate the school you're attending. It's an annual tradition for most American high schools (and some colleges and universities, too!) There are a ton of activities that center on homecoming, and they vary from school to school. The celebrations generally start within the school on Monday and last all the way through the weekend.

When is Homecoming? Homecoming week is October 7-12. The Homecoming Dance will be October 12th from 6:30-8:30 at the F89 School. FMHS Homecoming is the same week as ours, with their dance on Oct 12th from 7:30-10:30.

What is the theme? This year's theme is *Above the Clouds, Under the Stars*

Can 8th graders be involved?

Yes! The F8/9 homecoming will involve the WHOLE school. 8th and 9th graders are both invited to the homecoming dance and school activities.

Is there going to be a dance? Yes! What would homecoming be without a dance? The dance will be held on SATURDAY, October 12th from 6:30-8:30.

Can freshman attend both dances?

Definitely! But they have to buy tickets for both of them if they are planning on attending. The FMHS dance is on October 12th from 7:30-10:30. **The dances were designed especially for freshmen wishing to "double-dip" in the Homecoming fun – leave a bit early from the F89 dance to arrive fashionably late at FMHS. There is a discounted ticket package for those freshmen wanting to attend both dances.**

Can non-F8/9 students attend the F89 dance? Yes, as long as they are registered by Thursday 10/10. Dance Guest Registration forms are available on the F8/9 website and need to be signed by parents AND administration. Students must be in at least the 8th grade.

Who will chaperone the dance? F89 staff and Administrators will chaperone the dance. Remember the dance ends at 8:30 so please make sure your student is picked up on time.

Are student ID's required?

Yes!!! You need them to be able to enter the dance at F8/9 or FMHS.

What do you wear to the dance? Homecoming is considered a “semi-casual” dance. Ladies wear dresses and men wear slacks and a button-up shirt (with or without a tie). You do NOT dress up as a character from the theme for the dance. You do NOT need to rent a tuxedo.

Do you have to have a “date” to go to Homecoming? Nope! In fact, many students come to the dance in large groups of friends.

How much is the dance? F89 Homecoming tickets purchased prior to the dance are \$8 with an SBA and \$10 without. Tickets purchased at the door will be \$14 each. Tickets will be sold at lunch beginning 10/7. Tickets will also be available to purchase in the main office or in room 176. Students need to bring their student ID in order to receive the SBA discount.

Going to both Dances? FRESHMEN ONLY may purchase “Double the Dance” tickets. Students will receive a ticket for the F89 dance, FMHS dance, and \$2 in F89 concession certificates. Cost for “Double the Dance” is \$18 w/SBA and \$22 without. This deal is only available with pre-sold tickets.



Will there be a photographer? Yep! Legacy Photography will be there to take professional pictures. There will be a choice of several packages ranges in cost from \$10-\$50. There will also be options for groups as well. Photos will begin at 6:30 but can be taken at any point during the night. A price sheet is available at the F89 website.
